# DATES FOR SECOND COLLECTIONS EPARCHIAL CHARITIES APPEAL & ASSESSMENTS

February 15, 2009 United States Catholic Bishops' Worldwide Charities

(This collection combines the **four** USCCB collections: Central and Eastern Europe, the Church in Latin America, Catholic Relief Services, and Operation Rice Bowl [which is

part of CRS]. The total is divided accordingly.)

February 23 – Eparchial Charities Appeal

**April 11 (Lent)** (Divided as follows: 30% priests' retirement fund, 25% seminary, 15% endowment fund,

15% Patriarchal liturgical commission & texts,

15% Lebanon.)

April 10, 2009 Holy Land Collection

(Good Friday) (Part of this collection is sent through the USCCB to the Holy Land and another part is

sent directly to the Maronite Eparchy of Haifa.)

**April 26, 2009** Catholic Home Missions Appeal

(This collection is used for Missions in the USA. Our Eparchy has received large grants

from the USCCB from this collection for several years.)

May 3, 2009 National Shrine of Our Lady of Lebanon

**Feast of O. L.** (All funds collected are sent from the Chancery directly to our Shrine in North

of Lebanon Jackson, Ohio.)

May 17, 2009 Catholic Communications Campaign

(Following the norms established by the USCCB, 50% of this collection is sent to them for national Catholic television, radio and other media, and 50% is retained by our

Eparchy for the Maronite Voice and any other communication needs we may have.)

June 28, 2009 Holy Father's Collection (Peter's Pence)

**Feast of Sts.** (The entire collection is sent to the Holy Father for him to assist with emergency

**Peter & Paul** financial assistance to aid the most needy throughout the world.)

September 13, 2009 Catholic University of America

(This collection provides funding for academic scholarships at CUA. Our own

seminarians are given a 50% discount in tuition.)

### October 18, 2009 World Mission Sunday (formerly, Propagation of the Faith)

(As established by the USCCB, 91% of this collection goes to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, and 9% to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association [CNEWA]).

#### December 6, 2009 Maronite Patriarchal Charities

(All the proceeds from this collection are sent directly to our Patriarch for his charitable works.)

**Second Collections** should be submitted to the Chancery within **2 weeks** of the collection. (These collections were scheduled in conjunction with the Latin Dioceses. If you would like promotional materials, please contact your local Latin Diocese.)

The Eparchial Charities Appeal should be submitted to the Chancery by May 1, 2009.

**Assessments** will be divided into 10 segments to be paid at the beginning of each month from February through November (inclusive).

(Note that the following three collections, authorized by the USCCB, are **not** taken is our Eparchy: Catholic Campaign for Human Development, Retirement Fund for Religious, and Black and Indian Missions.)
